

Prayer For Your Workplace

1. Create a list of people in your place of work – coworkers, those in authority over you and those you manage.
2. Ask the Lord for Scriptures to pray over individuals on your list and for your workplace. Pick Scriptures that speak to integrity, diligence, grace and unity in our work.

Colossians 3:23 – Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, 24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.

3. Pray these Scriptures over your coworkers and managers by name. Put this prayer list in an easily accessible place as a reminder. Pray for favor and grace to fulfill the purposes of God in their work and in their lives.

Psalms 90:17 – Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, establish the work of our hands!

4. Take time before work, during a break, or after work to pray for your office space. Walk around your office or office building. Pray as you drive to or from work. Pray for the kingdom of God to come in your place of work.
5. Start a prayer time in your workplace and invite coworkers. Ask others how you can pray for them or set up a drop box for prayer requests to pray for the needs of those you work with.
