



Easter Resources

1. **Attend Antioch's events** (best for older kids due to the reflective nature of these services):
 - a. Maundy Thursday service — Thursday, March 28, 6:30 - 7:30 p.m. in the Auditorium.
 - b. Good Friday Service — Friday, March 29, 6:30 - 7:30 p.m. in the Auditorium.
 - c. Stations of the Cross — Friday and Saturday, March 29 & 30, in the Lobby.
March 29 is 9 a.m. - 9 p.m. March 30 is 8 a.m. to noon.
2. **Participate in the Impact Waco Easter Event** on Saturday, March 30, from noon to 2 p.m. at Seley Park.
3. **Download Lifeway Kids' 8-day Easter Devotional** for families, covering Palm Sunday through Easter Sunday. (scan QR code above)
4. **Host a nice Easter meal** with your family and friends. Around the table, ask, "What is your favorite part of the Easter story?" Have everyone share, then finish by taking communion.
5. **Watch Bible Project's video** on the resurrection as a family, then talk about which parts stood out to you. (scan QR code)
6. **Make "Resurrection Rolls"** with your kids. This helps your young ones hear the Easter story in a creative way. (scan QR code)
7. **Host an Easter egg hunt** in your neighborhood with your neighbors or friends and add resurrection Easter eggs (buy at Mardel, or you can create at home) for some of the eggs. After all eggs are gathered, enjoy the candy and share the Easter story.
8. **Make cookies for your neighbors** as a family, and as you deliver them, invite your neighbors to Antioch's Easter services.
9. **Watch the Easter story** from Saddleback Kids if you have Pre-K and Elementary students. Afterward, talk about it as a family! (scan QR code)
10. **Make "Resurrection Cookies"** with your kids — this gives kids an interactive experience while making cookies together and talking about Easter. (scan QR code)
